The Tournament will be USBC Certified. Bowlers must be Cowlitz USBC Youth members or be prepared to purchase a card at the time of the tournament. Entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to each squad.

Tournament Format:

- a. Tournament will be held March 29 & 30, 2025. Bowlers must check in 30 minutes prior to their squad time. Practice will start 10 minutes prior to each squad time. Squad times are as follows: Saturday at 1:00 pm & 4:00 pm. Sunday at 10:00 am and 1:00 pm.
 - b. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 200.
 - c. There will be 2 separate events. Doubles & Singles. Bowlers DO NOT have to bowl in every event. *Multiple entries are allowed. You must bowl with a different partner each time for doubles. You may bowl singles multiple times, but you can only cash once.*
 - d. In each event, 3 games will be bowled. Total pins plus handicap will determine final standings. In the event of a tie prize money will be split.
2. Entering Averages:
- a. All entrants will use their highest league average, of at least 9 games, as of March 1, 2025. If no average as of March 1, 2025, the highest league average, of at least 9 games, as of March 30, 2025 will be used.
 - b. If no average can be found, the bowler will be required to use a 160 average.
 - c. No sport league averages will be used. If the bowler only has a sport league average we will use the bowl.com "Average Adjustment Chart".
 - d. The coach is responsible for making sure the correct averages are used and the bowler is a USBC certified member.
 - e. The tournament director reserves the right to re-rate any bowler.
3. Tournament Expenses and Prize Fund:
- a. Entry fee per bowler is \$20.00 per person/event.
 - b. Per bowler/event- \$20.00 as follows: \$12.00 Lineage, and \$8.00 to prize fund.
 - c. Prize Ratio for trophies is 1:4.
 - d. First place in every event will receive \$25.00 in scholarship money.
 - e. All prize money will be deposited into SMART account #11130.
4. Team Line-up:
- a. Tournament entrants must bowl in the order in which their names appear on the entry form. Substitutes must take the place vacated by the absent member. Rule 324a does not apply.
5. Dress Code:
- a. Collared shirts or a bowling jersey are required.
6. Appeals:
- a. Any appeal or protest regarding tournament scoring or entering averages must be made in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of bowling.
