

Women's City Tournament 2024

The Tournament will be USBC Certified. Bowlers must be Cowlitz USBC members or be prepared to purchase a card at the time of the tournament. Entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to each squad.

1. Tournament Format:
 - a. The tournament will be held March 8 & 9, 2025. Bowlers must check in 30 minutes prior to their squad time. Practice will start 10 minutes prior to each squad time. Squad times are as follows: Saturday at 1:00 pm & 4:00 pm. Sunday at 10:00 am and 1:00 pm.
 - b. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220.
 - c. There will be 2 separate events. Doubles & Singles. Bowlers DO NOT have to bowl in every event. *Multiple entries are allowed. You must bowl with a different partner each time for doubles. You may bowl singles multiple times, but you can only cash once.*)
 - d. In each event, 3 games will be bowled. Total pins plus handicap will determine final standings. In the event of a tie prize money will be split.
2. Entering Averages:
 - a. All entrants will use their highest book average of 21 games or more for the 2023-2024 season.
 - b. If no average can be found, the bowler will use their highest current average of 12 or more games at the time of bowling. All others will bowl scratch.
 - c. No sport league averages will be used. If the bowler only has a sport league average, we will use the bowl.com "Average Adjustment Chart".
 - d. Rule 319a will apply.
 - e. The tournament director reserves the right to re-rate any bowler.
3. Tournament Expenses and Prize Fund:
 - a. Entry fee per bowler is \$30.00 per person/event.
 - b. Per bowler/event- \$30.00 as follows: \$12.00 Lineage, and \$17.50 to the prize fund and \$.50 for awards.
 - c. Prize Ratio for tournament will be 1:4.
4. Team Line-up:
 - a. Tournament entrants must bowl in the order in which their names appear on the entry form. Report all substitutes to the Tournament Director 30 minutes prior to squad time. Rule 324a does not apply.
5. Appeals:
 - a. Any appeal or protest regarding tournament scoring or entering averages must be made in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of bowling.
